

ORDINANCE 2019-3

AN ORDINANCE TO ABOLISH THE JAMESTOWN TOWN COURT

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Jamestown, Indiana, desires to abolish the Jamestown Town Court; and

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 33-35-1-1(d) permits a Town Court in existence on January 1, 1986, to continue in existence and operation until it is abolished by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Court of Jamestown was created by Ordinance No. 82-6 passed December 7, 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Jamestown, Indiana, as follows:

Article 1 – Abolishment of the Town Court:

The Jamestown Town Court is hereby abolished pursuant to Indiana Code 33-35-1-1.

Article 2 – Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall become in full force and effect thirty (30) days from its publication date, formally abolishing the Court on April 10, 2019.


